### **Information Bulletin August 2000.**

The date is drawing closer and the pace is picking up.

#### ACCOMMODATION

**Roseworthy Campus** The houses have all been taken **but** a large number of the 110 rooms are **still available**. These rooms are single bedrooms equipped with a single bed, chair, desk and wardrobe. Residents will have full use of the common kitchens, bathrooms and toilet facilities. The rooms offer security but are not airconditioned. A large swimming pool is also available to all residents. The cost of these rooms is very reasonable at \$A70 a week. Management will advise us if more houses become available in the next couple of months.

**Hillier Park cabins.** 4 self contained and airconditioned cabins were available, however they have now been booked.

**The Prasad Motel** Still has a number of airconditioned double or twin rooms available at \$A80 a night per room.

**EPIRB'S** The rules state that electronic locator beacons must be carried by all pilots for this event. The organisers are negotiating the hire of some of these units for those pilots that require them.

Official Closing Ceremony This will be held on Saturday, 27th January, 2001, the day after the last contest day. The ceremony will be held at the Gawler aerodrome at about 10.30 in the morning.
